

Example of enhanced provision based on the story *What the Ladybird Heard*

Small World - farm animals, robbers and ladybird in sand tray

Investigation minibeast hunt (magnifying glasses & identification fans)

What the ladybird heard
by Julia Donaldson

Construction - build a new shed for the prize cow

Writing Table - create a map of the farmyard and label
Use key words from story to read/write sentences

Playdough - make a ladybird (add eyes, legs and spots)


Role Play - use laminated lolly stick puppets in theatre or sequence pictures and words to retell story

Offering opportunities for children that they **may or may not** want to engage in.

Adult Led Activity

ICT – understand how to operate simple equipment and program the beebot (programmable toy) to move.

Children to use beebot to move around the farm.



Example of enhanced provision based on the story *The Gruffalo*

The Gruffalo by Julia Donaldson

Investigation - how can you mix paint to make gruffalo brown or purple prickles?

Construction - Can you make a tree-top house for owl?

Writing Table - What is the most terrible creature you can imagine?

Small World
Take the little mouse and his friends on a stroll in the deep dark wood

Playdough - Can you make scrambled snake using playdough?


Role Play - What is on the menu at the Gruffalo cafe?

Offering opportunities for children that they may **or may not** want to engage in.

Adult Led Activity

Shared writing – Show letter from Gruffalo and use to inspire writing a shared letter back to the Gruffalo.

Model writing – school's script, correct letter formation, using terms /language to support thinking



Example of enhanced provision based on the story *Jasper's Beanstalk*

Investigation
Measuring bean-stalks of different lengths (pictures)
Put in size order

Construction -
Build a tower taller than a beanstalk...

Writing Table -
Write on bean-stalk leaves

Outside -
growing beanstalks (jam jar and bean experiment and small pots and compost)

Sand Tray- rakes, spades, hose, plant pots, watering cans, days of the week laminated

Role Play - have selection of wellies and gardening gloves and tools - garden shed

Offering opportunities for children that they **may or may not** want to engage in.

Adult Led Activity

Shared writing – tell the children they will be authors and illustrators! Create a book with a small group of children using the structure of *Jasper's Beanstalk*.

Ask the children to choose a character and name. On Monday.... On Tuesday.... Through to On Sunday.... Model writing – school's script, correct letter formation, using terms /language to support thinking

Ask the children to draw the pictures for the story.
